Dear Mr. Cruce:

In response to my letter to you earlier today, you have provided to the Department additional documentation confirming that you meet the durational residency requirement as the nominated candidate for the Democratic Party to fill the vacancy in the State Senate District 1 seat for the upcoming Special Election on February 15, 2025. More specifically, you submitted Delmarva Power electric utility bills dating from February 2023 through January 2025, indicating continuous occupancy of your residence in Senate District 1 at the address listed above. In addition, you provided a letter, dated today, from Delmarva Power Customer Service Manager Darren Massey indicating that you have been a customer of the utility at the address listed above as of December 2, 2014.

I have reviewed the materials referenced above and have determined that they further reconfirm the Department's original determination that you have satisfied the durational residency requirement for the office for which you have been nominated, per the provisions of the Delaware Constitution, Article II, § 3 (a). As such, I consider the complaint received by the Department on February 5, 2025, questioning if you satisfy these requirements of the office for which you have been nominated, to be resolved.
